MAJOR ACTIVITIES

SiTI – Istituto Superiore sui Sistemi Territoriali per l’Innovazione (Higher Institute on Territorial Systems for Innovation) is a non-profit association set up in 2002 between the Politecnico di Torino and the Compagnia di San Paolo, to carry out research and training oriented towards innovation and socio-economic growth.

SiTI is a permanent organization of the Compagnia di San Paolo, with a strong interdisciplinary approach, specifically devoted to territorial systems. Its activities are concentrated in the following sectors: **Logistics and transport** (this sector has a specific know-how in the field of mobility and transportation of freight and people, mobility demand analysis, traffic models, transport planning and scenarios assessment).

Environmental heritage and urban redevelopment (the research activities regard conservation, defence of the natural and cultural components of the environmental systems and urban redevelopment, cultural heritage and management plans, tourism management).

Environmental protection (this sector carries out research on security and safety of critical infrastructures and cultural heritage).

The Institute develops its researches and carries out projects both financed by national and international institutions.
